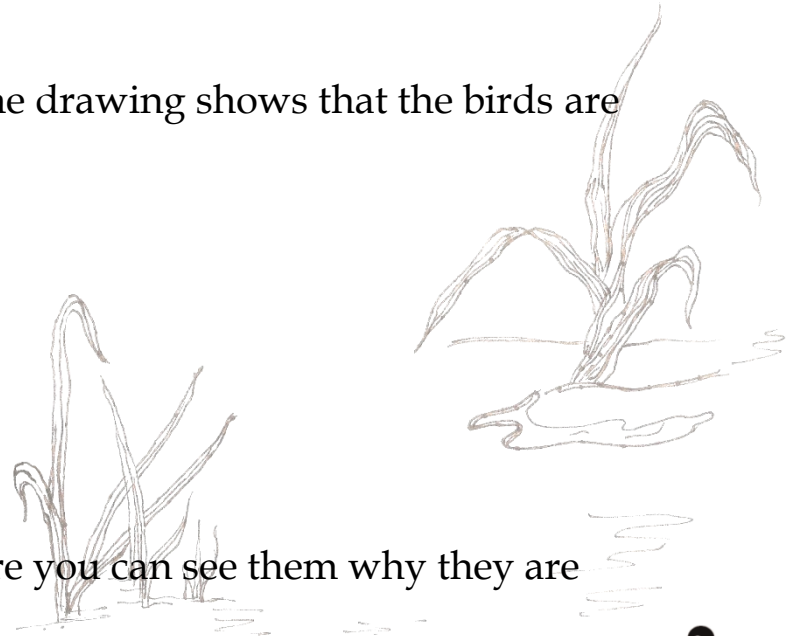

- The slender up-turned bill is swept from side to side in water and mud to look for tiny creatures like molluscs and insects.
- The birds are mostly seen in wetlands, especially near the coastal areas.
